

## Confirmation Preparation Requirements For Catholic School Student

The process for Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation at St. Helen for catholic school students is a one-year process. Catholic school students are exempt from the two-year requirement due to the theology credits they receive at school.

All confirmation candidates must be in 10<sup>th</sup> grade or above.

## Prior to entering the Confirmation Year 2 Youth must be simultaneously enrolled. and attending faith formation

- Students and Parents attend a confirmation intro meeting, September 24, 2023.
- All students must attend Sunday Mass every week: Saturday 5:00PM Vigil English Sunday 7:30am, 9:00am, 10:30am, 5:00pm Sunday Noon Spanish
- Attend Holy Days of Obligation
- Students must attend 80% of Highschool faith formation.
- Students will participate in at least 30 service hours. \*Hours
   completed towards the community service projects required by the
   school will count towards the required 30 hours of service\*
- Attend confirmation retreat \*If catholic school students can't attend the confirmation retreat with St. Helen the Kairos retreat will be accepted as well.

- Attend the parent/sponsor day of reflection.
- Complete the confirmation application packet.
- Copy of Baptismal Certificate with first communion notification
- Youth must attend confirmation reconciliation service.
- Saint paper or reel
- Participate in the confirmation entry and exit interviews.
- Sponsor interview

## **Parents and sponsors:**

- Parents must attend confirmation parent sessions.
- Sponsor/ Parent Day of reflection
